With due respect and humble submission, I would like to inform you that all the current three (3) semester History Honours students, along with the faculty members of the Department of History, are planning to visit the Bharat - Bangladesh Maitri Uddan, Bharabnagar, Chottakhola (Belonia), South Tripura, a historical site in the state of Tripura on 21<sup>st</sup> January 2023 (Saturday). The Department of History has a tradition of taking its History Honours students for a yearly mandatory visit to a historical site of the state of Tripura. Still, due to the Covid-19 pandemic, the Department had to stop this exercise from an overall safety concern. As a result, none of the current semester's honours students of the Department was taken to any historical site of the state of Tripura as an extended curricular activity of the course. So, the yearly mandatory departmental educational tour is pending for all three current semesters. The Department feels that this is the right time in the post-Covid era to take all the Department's students for the yearly mandatory departmental educational tour.

The total number of students expected to visit the Museum would be (1<sup>st</sup> sem Hist. Hons – 40, 3<sup>rd</sup> sem Hist. Hons – 19 and 5<sup>th</sup> sem Hist. Hons – 17 = 76 [total]) and the four (4) faculty of the Department are also expected to accompany the students for proper guidance. So, the Department feels it would be great from the side of the college administration if two (2) college buses could be provided to take the 76 students and four faculty of the Department from the HCCA Jubatara campus to Bharat - Bangladesh Maitri Uddan, Bharabnagar, Chottakhola (Belonia), South Tripura on 21<sup>st</sup> January 2023 (Saturday) and back. The buses could leave the college campus at 6.00 AM for the Bharat - Bangladesh Maitri Uddan, Bharabnagar, Chottakhola (Belonia), South Tripura.

## Report

### Departmental: Historical Educational Tour Bharat-Bangladesh Maitri-Udyan Study Tour

The first, third and fifth semester honors students of the history Department along with the four (4) faculty members of the Department went for a Educational Tour on 21<sup>st</sup> January, 2023 at the Bharat-Bangladesh Maitri Udyan, This place has a great significance in the realm of contemporary history, as this place initially [later turned into a tourist park] as one of the base camps used by the Bangladeshi Freedom Fighters at Chottakhola, from where they launched guerrilla operations against the Pakistani army in Chittagong, Comilla, and larger Noakhali.

The park was created at Chottakhola, close to the international border, as a memorial to the Indian soldiers and Bangladeshi Freedom Fighters who gave their lives in the Liberation War. On December 16, Bangladesh Victory Day, the memorial, and park were officially opened by former Tripura Chief Minister Manik Sarkar in the presence of Indian and Bangladeshi artists, academics, and independence warriors. On November 11th, 2010, the park's foundation stone was placed by Dipu Moni, who was Bangladesh's Education Minister at the time.

Famous artists from Tripura and Bangladesh contributed to the project and offered their works of art, including statues and paintings, to the memorial's appeal. The memorial park would teach Bangladesh's future generations about the history of their fought-for independence and how the two amicable neighbors collaborated to bring about the nation's founding. **A total of fifty-seven (57) students from the department has visited** the Maitri-Udyan to have/gather a firsthand experience on the contribution of Indian and Tripura in the liberation war of Bangladesh. The whole educational tour gave the students of the department a fulfilling satisfaction.

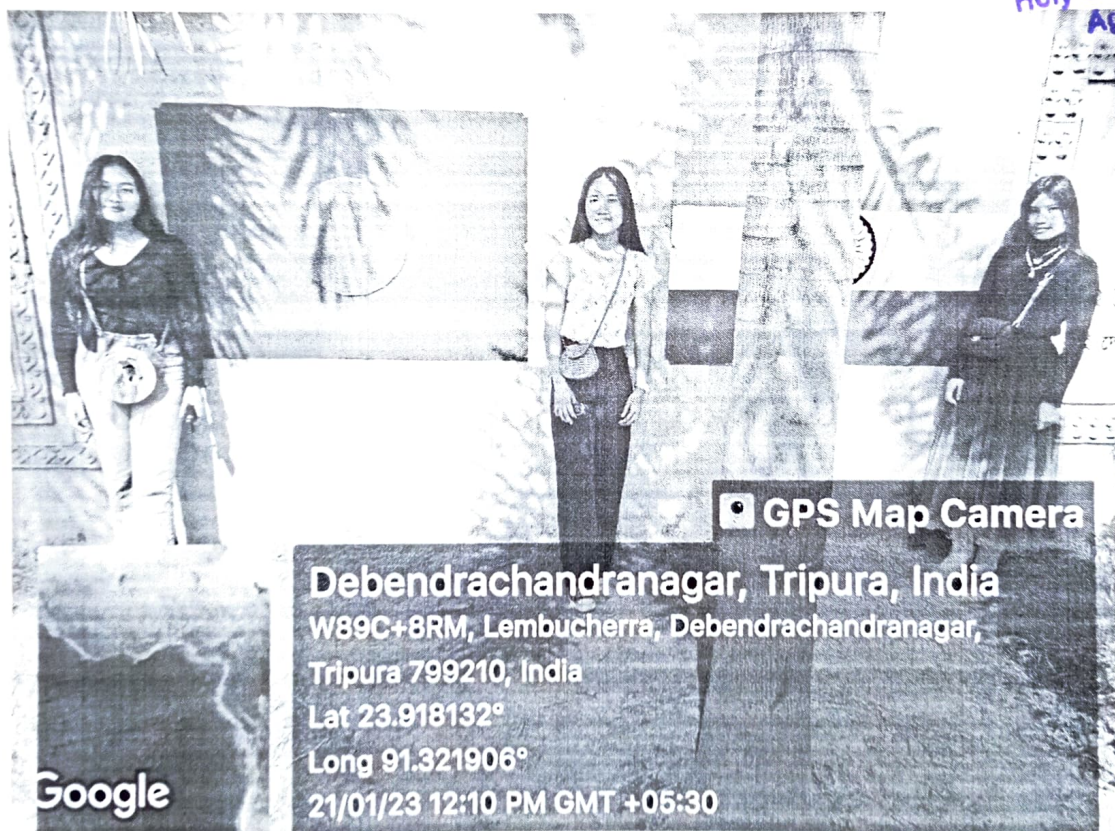

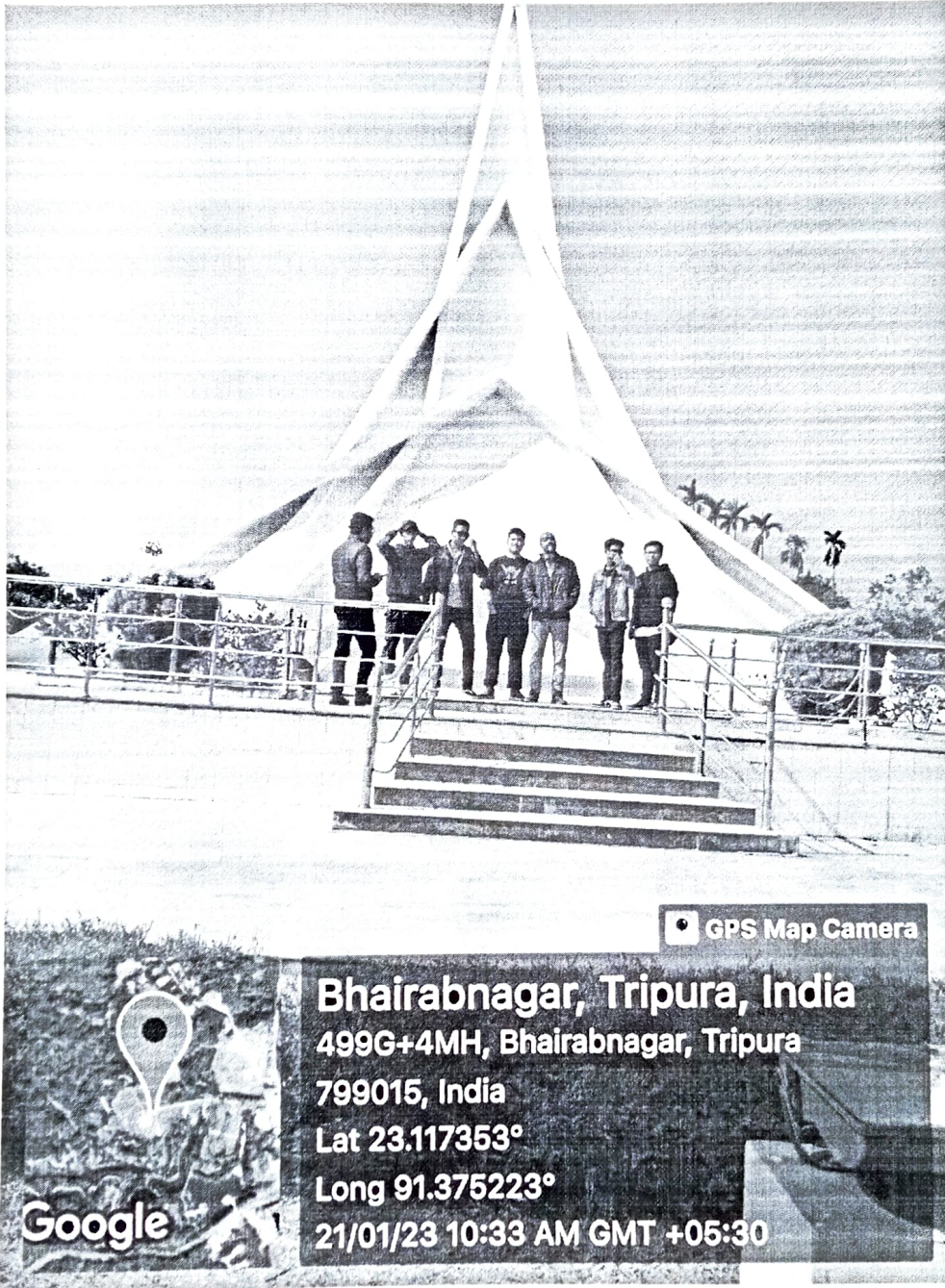

## Educational Excursion

Department of Commerce arranged an educational excursion to 'Special Economic Zone' at Sabroom with 21 students and 5 faculty members of the department on **4<sup>th</sup> June, 2022**. Students and faculty members visited Special Economic Zone and had an interaction session with SDM official Mr. D. Debbarma. Students came to know about the SEZ, multi modal hubs, cargo railway, etc and SEZ's future planning & importance. The SDM official personal explained elaborately about all the aspects, from purchasing of land by the state Govt., boundary wall construction, electricity connectivity, railway connectivity, etc. and also gave answers of various questions asked by the students and the faculty members. It was indeed a fruitful session for the students.

Then we visited Ludhua Tea processing factory for exhibiting students hand on practical experience of the work going in the factory. Starting from collection of tea leaves, spreading them on the dryer, moving the dried leaves in the machine, bring out the finished product in various quality. The students also had an interaction session with the tea factory manager. First he explained about the processing unit and then very patiently gave answers of various questions asked by the students.

Then after taking lunch at Sabroom town, we went for local sightseeing and visited 'Maitri Setu' at Indo-Bangla Border. Students were explained the importance of the 'Maitri Setu', which connects Bangladesh and Tripura. In future, this route will be used to carry goods from various states of India through Chittagong Port to Tripura. As a result of which, Tripura will get the goods at short period of time and at low carrying cost.

## **Diet Survey**

**Date: 10<sup>th</sup> December, 2022**

Diet survey can be defined as a way of studying food consumption of an individual or a family. Techniques of conducting the survey includes questionnaires, maintaining a food diary, weighing intake and chemical analysis of food. Diet Survey is important that helps determine where population is defined by age, sex, race, ethnicity, income, urbanization or education are at risk for energy and nutrient deficiencies.

On 10th of December 2022 a Diet survey programme and educational tour was organised by the Department of Human Physiology of Holy Cross College for the 3<sup>rd</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> semester students. The students conducted their survey at Rajghat village of Melaghar in Sepahijala district of Tripura. We were also joined by our 3<sup>rd</sup> year Seniors of H. Phy., Zoology, Botany and B.Sc. general Departments. The students proceeded with the survey by dividing themselves into many groups - each consisting of ten members. The groups visited families collecting information regarding their daily intake of food required for normal growth, metabolism, proper functioning of body and maintaining good health. One group visited the house of Mr. Satish Das whose family consisted of seven members while another group visited the house of Mr. Suman Das who is living with 3 of his family members. With this, we got to know about their different types of food consumption that are of proteins, carbohydrates, cereals, fats, oils along with their physical activity level, present/past illness and many more. After the household survey is over, we went for lunch in a hotel. Then we all visited the Neermahal using the boat for a while as a part of refreshment for us.

This Survey and Educational tour would not have been possible without the presence Dr. Sandeep Roy Sarkar, HoD, Human Physiology, Dr. Balaram Sutradhar, Asst. ## **REPORT ON EDUCATIONAL TRIP TO JAMPUI HILLS**

25<sup>th</sup> – 27<sup>th</sup> November, 2022

### **INTRODUCTION:**

The Department of Sociology at Holy Cross College organized a three-day educational trip for its students to Jampui Hills in Tripura. The itinerary included visits to Betlingchhip (located in Phuldungsei), the highest peak in Tripura, and Vanghmun, renowned as the cleanest village in the state. The students also had the opportunity to explore the famous Orange gardens of Jampui Hills and immerse themselves in the local culture, gaining knowledge about various cultural aspects. Additionally, the students had gone on a field survey to gather information about the socio-economic conditions of the residents of Phuldungsei. This allowed them to gain a practical understanding of the challenges faced by the local community and the ways in which they cope with them. The field survey proved to be an enriching experience for the students, providing them with hands-on learning and valuable insights into the lives of the local people. During their visit, the students were also captivated by the mesmerizing sunrise and sunset, the eco-friendly surroundings, and the vibrant dance and music performances of the Bru and Mizo communities. The educational trip proved to be a resounding success as it provided the students with a comprehensive understanding of research methodologies to collect data and gain in-depth knowledge about the cultures, traditions, social structures, and languages of the Bru (Reang) and Mizo communities of Jampui Hills. The experience also left an indelible mark on the students, providing them with invaluable and unforgettable memories that cannot be replaced by any other lesson.

### **OBJECTIVES OF EDUCATION TOUR:**

- It aimed to familiarize the students with diverse socio-cultural patterns, value systems, and social practices prevalent in different parts of Tripura.
- It aimed to provide students with a broader understanding of different cultures through purposeful recreation, sightseeing, and discussions in various locations and environments.
- The trip also aimed to provide students with a hands-on learning experience on the application of various research methodologies to collect data, enabling them to develop a comprehensive understanding of the cultures, traditions, social structures, and languages of the local communities of Jampui Hills.



## REPORTS FROM THE STUDENT, DEPARTMENT OF SOCIOLOGY

On the morning of November 25<sup>th</sup>, 2022, 31 students from BA(Hons) Sociology and 2 students from BA General who were tired of the monotonous city life and yearning for a break, set out from their college in search of knowledge and an enjoyable experience that went beyond the traditional classroom learning.

Our journey began early in the morning from Agartala by train and arrived at Pencharthal station at 11 am. From there, we were transported in two SUVs and one open roof top pick-up truck to Phuldungsei. The scenic view of the mountains during the journey was breathtaking. As we drove through the jungle, we passed by small bamboo houses on the hillsides, which were both stunning and slightly eerie. We arrived at our destination, MJ Homestay in Phuldungsei, around 3:45 pm. Upon arrival at the homestay, we were promptly served lunch. Following our meal, we were given some leisure time to explore the village of Phuldungsei. Later in the evening, a bonfire atmosphere was arranged by the homestay, where some of us sat together near the fire.

The next day, a group of early risers witnessed a serene sunrise from the rooftop of their homestay between the hours of 4:00am and 6:00am. After taking in the picturesque views and snapping some photos, the group came down to enjoy a delicious breakfast. Following breakfast, each student was given a survey sheet before embarking on a trek to Betlingchhip, the highest peak in Tripura. The view from the watchtower at the peak was breathtaking, offering a stunning panoramic vista of the Jampui hills. Upon returning from the trek, we were split up into four teams, each accompanied by a local guide. We conducted a survey of the local households, using the guides as interpreters to facilitate communication. The survey revealed that the economy of the Jampui hills was largely dependent on orange and arecanut plantation farming, as well as jhum cultivation. The residents of Phuldungsei followed a set of community norms, such as restrictions on chicken farming and keeping pigs in pens. The group also observed that the locals in Phuldungsei woke up early in the morning to engage in jhuming. The major issues in the area were water scarcity and a lack of local transportation options.

After completing our survey, we decided to explore the nearby orange garden and savored the juicy, fresh oranges that it had to offer. We then went back to our homestay, had lunch, rested for an hour, and headed to a local picnic spot called 'VP Picnic Spot.' The sunset at the picnic spot was stunning and had a calming ambiance. We even climbed a hillock that surrounded the picnic spot, which was both exhausting and fun. On top of the hill, we sat in a tourist shed shaped like a circle, where we talked and laughed. While at the picnic spot, some of the students tried on Mizo attire and took pictures. After a busy day, we returned to our

homestay, freshened up, and prepared for a bonfire in the outside compound. A few of us visited the nearby church before joining the rest at the bonfire. We enjoyed playing several games while being entertained with cultural performances by both locals and our group members. The day ended with a delightful dinner alongside the bonfire session.

Before our journey came to an end, we had one final destination on our itinerary - Vanghmun village, known as the cleanest village in Tripura. As we arrived, we were impressed by the village's cleanliness, with several dustbins placed at regular intervals throughout the area. The village had a peaceful atmosphere with well-maintained houses and trimmed bushes. We took a stroll down the village street, interacted with some locals, visited a church, received blessings, and captured some memorable pictures. After exploring Vanghmun, we began our journey back to Agartala.

It was an unforgettable journey that enriched us in ways beyond our imagination, and no amount of description can do justice to the beauty and significance of those moments. Sometimes, it's just best to cherish these experiences in our hearts and let them continue to inspire and shape us as we move forward in life.

8. Carry extra cash, snacks and water bottles/flask.

**EDUCATIONAL TOUR ARRANGEMENT:**

- Our educational tour team to Jampui Hills comprised of thirty-three students and three faculty members.



- It was a trip of 3 days and 2 nights.
- MJ Homestay is a government recognized homestay that offers a variety of services such as accommodation, travel arrangements, picnics, visits to orange gardens, and trekking. They organized an educational trip that included accommodation, food, cultural night with bonfire, sightseeing, trekking to Betlingchip, and transportation from Pencharthal to Phuldengsei, and vice versa, for a cost of Rs 2,500 per student. However, the tour did not cover the expenses of the train journey from Agartala to Pencharthal and back, lunch on the return day, and any snacks. To cover these additional costs, an additional amount of Rs. 500 was collected from each student.
- The institution provided financial assistance by reimbursing 50% of the bill that was generated.

A field trip was carried out on 9<sup>TH</sup> December 2022 (11:00 am to 02:00pm) for the students of 3<sup>rd</sup> Semester, Zoology (General) Holy Cross College, to study the terrestrial fauna. The study was carried out at Debendrachandranagar, West Tripura which is 1.02 kilometers away from our college. The studied area comprised mainly of *Hevea Brasiliensis*, *Mangifera indica*, *Ficus elastica*. Small agricultural fields of *Oryza sativa* was also present.

To understand the density and diversity of the terrestrial fauna, students of 3<sup>rd</sup> semester (B.Sc. Zoology -General) had made a wide range of observation covering a scarcely populated area adjoining a mixed forest area.

Students were divided into small groups. They studied the faunal diversity, classified the different specimens on spot by observation; without actually harming any of them.

The overall observations revealed that the studied area was composed of a wide group of animal species which included total Sixteen (16) identified species. The identified species occupied three (3) phyla amongst four (4) order of ten (10) families. Phylum Arthropoda seemed to be very diversified group. There were casts of various species of earthworms (Phylum Annelida) as well.

Butterfly is an indicator species and represent the diversity and responses of other wildlife. It indicates that the area is very rich in Biodiversity. Specimens of this insect order (Lepidoptera) were photographed. *Junonia atlites*, *Ixias pyrene*, *Acytolepis puspa*, *Pseudozizreria maha* are some of them. Some representatives of the insect order Odonata; popularly known as dragonflies were also recorded.

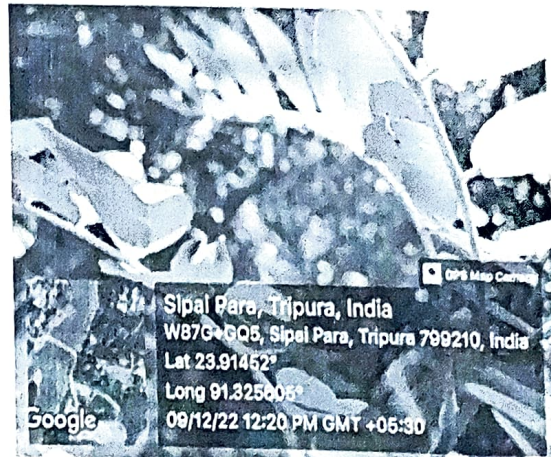
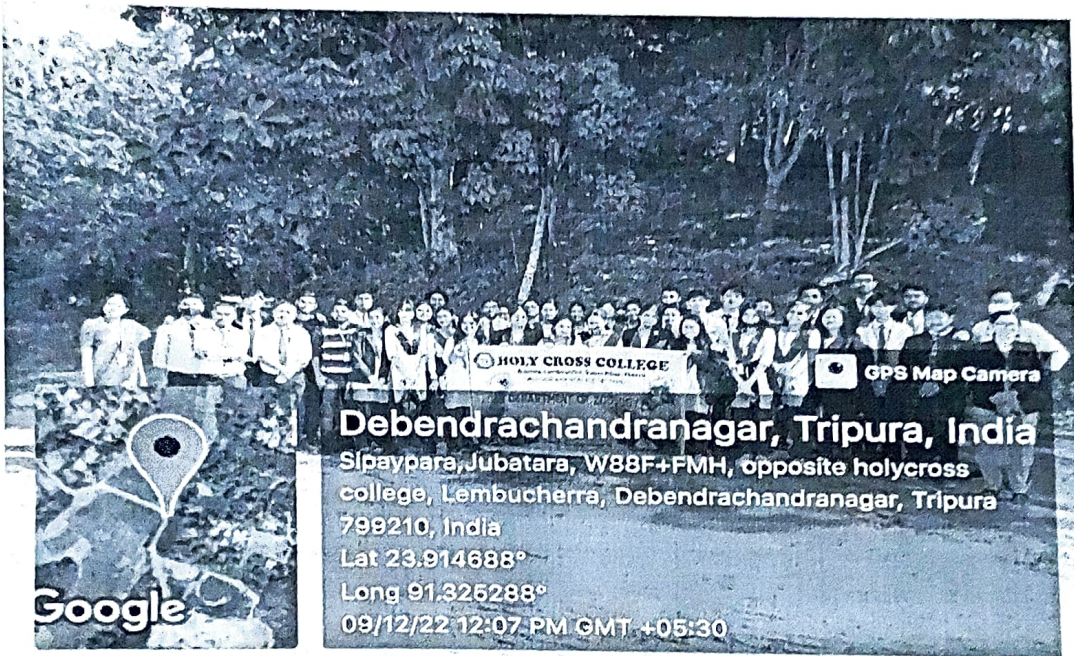

## **REPORT ON INTRASTATE FIELD TRIP TO NAGICHERA**

Held On 21/06/2022

**ORGANISED BY**

**Department Of Botany, Holy Cross College, Agartala**


Botanical studies of a local region not only are of a didactic value, but they are also the region they live in. Going outdoors, visiting nearby and farther surroundings (on their way from home to institute, on playgrounds, sightseeing sites, etc.), students, together with their teachers, can observe the principal properties, record and collect plants or analyze and describe plant communities and vegetation of the given region.

The tour was held on 21<sup>st</sup> June in Horticulture research Complex (HRC), near Nagicherra. All the faculties of the Department of Botany and lab technician were accompanied by the students. There was an interaction with the Director of HRC, Dr. Rajib Ghosh, who presented a short presentation where he discussed the following topics: 1. Research on Mushrooms and production of spawns. 2. Germplasm of different jhum vegetations. 3. Evaluation of commercial varieties of vegetables. 4. Seed production program. 5. Staggering pineapple. 6. Tissue culture activity. 7. Human resource development. At the end of the conference, students and teachers went to the mushroom culture center, visited tissue culture and moved back to the backyard of the culture medium room to visit the garden under the guidance of Rajasree Chacabarty, Agriculture Officer. Then after moving to another place a HRC staff demonstrated the process of grafting and then all went on a tour to the vegetation ground of HRC with another staff, where there were many plant species.

Field study is an essential part of Botany as plants are best studied in their natural habitat. The students get exposed to the plant kingdom. The students get practical knowledge of different species of plants like herbs, shrubs, climbers, and trees. Field trips provide authentic, hands-on experimental learning opportunities where we can connect what we are learning in the classroom to a real-world context. Thus, the trip not only provided us with knowledge but also widened our thoughts, explores our knowledge, and also made our learning more interesting.
