The Program Concluded with the Vote of Thanks by Miss Barnita Majumder, Asst. Prof., English, HCC.

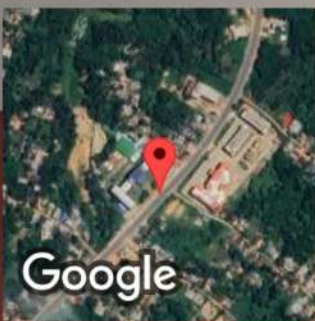
