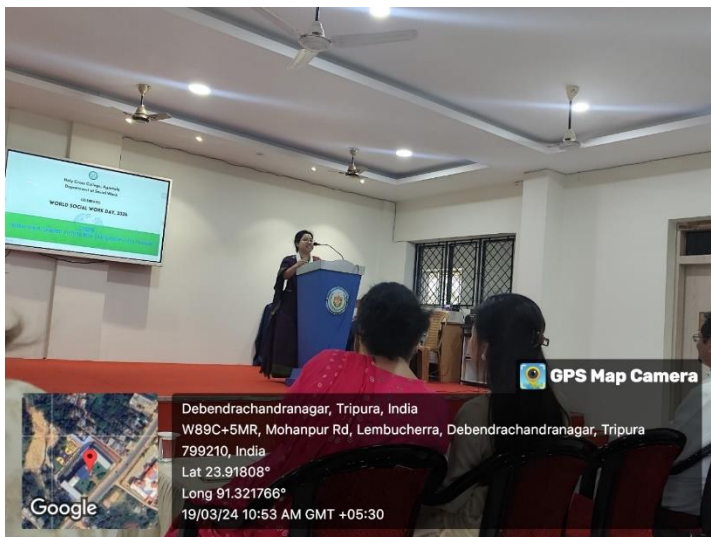
The program concluded with a heartfelt speech from Madam Lily Jamatia, the Head of the Social Work department, expressing gratitude to the chief guest and students for their

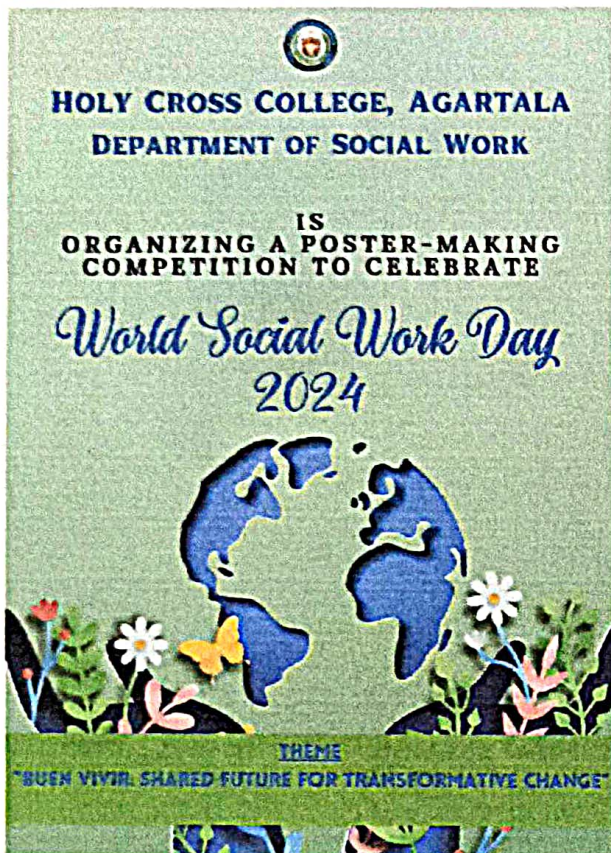

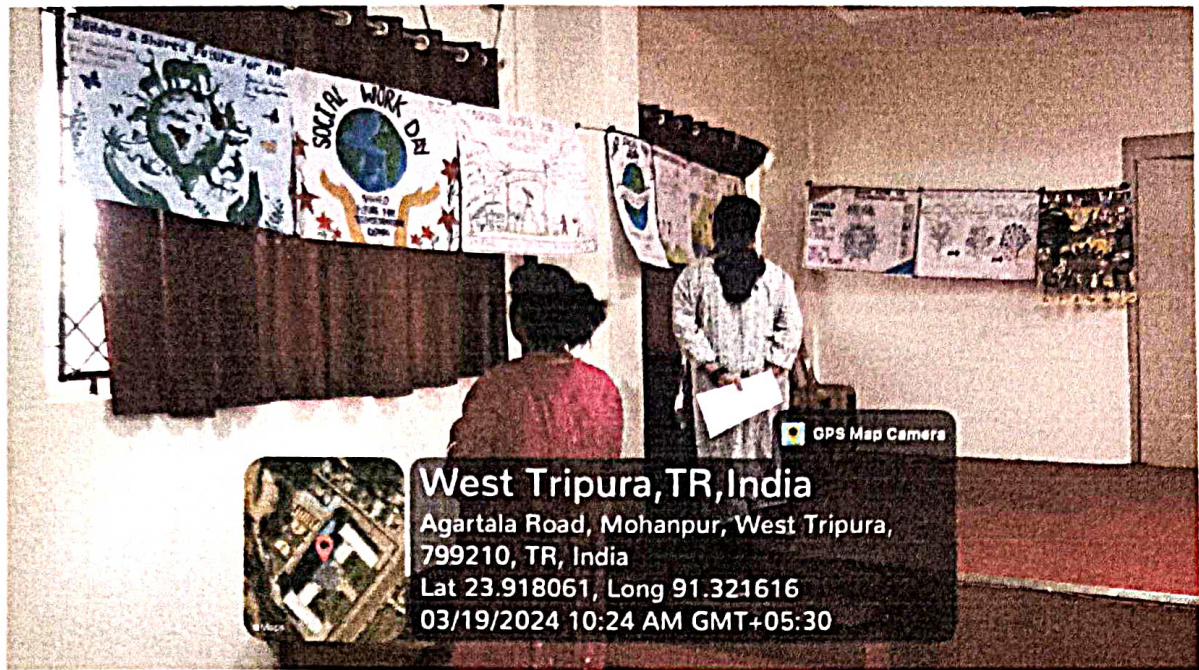
