

Report on Student's Exchange Program

On Wednesday, 27 April, 2022, the Political Science Department of Lady Brabourne College, Kolkata, organized an online student's exchange program on the topic, Ukraine-Russia Crisis, where two students from each institution, presented their individual papers on the given topic. From Holy Cross College, Agartala, Sreya Paul of Political Science Department, 6 Semester, presented her MS PowerPoint on the topic "Ukraine-Russia Crisis: India's Stand to Abstention".
