
Holy Cross College, Agartala Department of Social Work Organizational visits


towards integral social development. During its long journey on the path of social development, JUST has undertaken many programs for upliftment of the under privileged and the needy, in the State of Tripura.

3. Oisho Bani Society, on the 18th December 2023, the student Social Workers visited the organization.


