Dr. Sushobhan Sengupta elaborated on the Faculty Development Participation of 42 teachers in various FDP/Refresher courses/Training programs. He suggested making it mandatory for all teachers to participate in:

- NEP Sensitization Program
- Other training programs (at least once per year)

Agenda 6. Infrastructure Update

Fr. Joe Paul CSC, Vice Principal, provided updates on infrastructural developments (Andre Block extension is almost complete, new canteen is in progress, Boys Hostel is in progress, new lift has been installed for the students in the main block).

Sri. Kiran Hembrom, Industry Representative updated about the training of Teaching and nonteaching staff by their organization, institutional email, Library automation, college mobile app, also highlighted the need to update the college website and self KYC machines may be installed.

Agenda 7. Student Welfare Initiatives

Smt. Sentienla, Head of the Department of Sociology, highlighted new initiatives/programs aimed at enhancing student welfare. Financial Help is provided as scholarship, Mentoring, Counselling, Entrepreneurship development, remedial and tutorial classes, skill development and different MoU's for student and cultural exchange program.

Agenda 8. Research-Related Activities

Dr. Sandeep Roy Sarkar updated the house on research activities and ongoing research projects.

Agenda 9. Community Outreach and Social Responsibility

Smt. Sharmili Chakraborty, Head of the BBA Program, provided an update on community outreach programs and social responsibility initiatives taken by college during last year.

Agenda 10. Miscellaneous Discussions:

- Reconstitution of NAAC Criterion Committee was suggested by the house for better and proper documentation purpose.
- Submission of Application to HCEF: Principal presented a proposal to Fr. George for perusal and approval regarding post creation/dissolution.
- Recruitment of New Faculty Members: Dr. Sushobhan raised the need for a recruitment drive for teaching positions.
- Staff Retention Strategy: Dr. Sushobhan highlighted on retaining the top 20-30% of staff due to staff turnover. Management requested to develop a mechanism for retention, as these faculty members manage most college activities.
- **Proposal to Review Pay Structure**: With the 8th Pay Commission expected in 2026 in Tripura, Dr. Sushobhan proposed that the college administration may review the current pay structure and plan for necessary adjustments.
- Proposal for New Recruitment: Suggestions were made to recruit:
 - AI Trainer for Teachers and students.
 - Marketing Individual (for all promotion and marketing of college).
 - HR Personnel (for recruitment, pay negotiations, and pay review).
 - o Ombudsman as per UGC regulation.

The proposal was made by De. Sushobhan after receiving feedback from various department heads.

- Proposal for Private University/Aided College Status: Discussions on exploring the
 possibility of transitioning to a Private University or an Aided College.
- Students' representatives, proposed a new canteen in Andre Block, better placement opportunities and skilled based certificate courses.

The meeting concluded with a vote of thanks to the chair and all members for their active participation.
