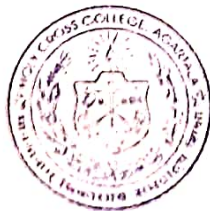

Introduction

The IT Club of Holy Cross College, Agartala in collaboration with the Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC), organized an E-Waste Collection Drive and Campaign on 13th February, 2025, at Hall No. G-8, Holy Cross College, Agartala. Session Highlights

Proper disposal of E-Waste: Highlighting the importance of designated e-waste collection centers and certified recyclers.

Types of pollution caused by E-Waste: Examining air, water, and soil pollution resulting from toxic components in discarded electronics.

Health Risks and Climate Change Impact: Discussing the hazardous effects of e-waste on human health and its contribution to global warming.

Action Plan for E-Waste Management: Proposing solutions to minimize e-waste, including adopting sustainable practices, and awareness campaigns.

Interactive Session and Activities

At the end of the discussion, a quiz session was conducted for students to test their knowledge and engagement with the topic. This interactive activity encouraged students to actively participate and reinforce their learning.

Following the quiz session, a sapling plantation ceremony was organized. The Principal, IQAC Coordinator, Academic Coordinator, members of the IT Club, and representatives from the Lions Club of Agartala ANISH planted saplings of Krishnachura and Radhachura plants within and outside the college premises as a symbolic gesture of commitment to environmental sustainability.


E-Waste Collection and Handover
