On March 10, 2025, the *Department of Sociology*, in collaboration with the *Gender Sensitization Cell (under ICC)*, organized a special screening of the film *Mrs.* as part of the International Women's Day celebrations. The event aimed to spread awareness about gender roles, societal expectations, and women's empowerment, with the theme "Her Power, Our Progress: The Road to Viksit Bharat." The film was chosen to encourage reflection on the evolving role of women in contemporary society and the importance of gender equality in national development.

The event commenced with opening remarks by Dr. Sharmistha Chakraborthy, Coordinator of the Gender Sensitization Cell, who shared the concept note of the screening, highlighting the significance of gender awareness and the role of media in challenging stereotypes. She emphasized that films like *Mrs.* serve as powerful tools to initiate dialogue on women's agency and the societal structures that shape their experiences. Following this, Dr. Moumita Dey, Presiding officer of Internal Complaints Committee (ICC), provided context for the film, setting the tone for the screening by discussing the impact of patriarchal traditions and the necessity of breaking gender barriers.

The movie Mrs. is a gripping social drama that portrays the journey of a woman as she navigates personal ambitions, marriage, and societal expectations. Through its compelling narrative, the film challenges traditional gender roles and highlights the significance of self-identity and independence. The screening was attended by 120 students and 16 faculty members, all of whom engaged deeply with the film's themes.

The event successfully generated discussions on the importance of empowering women to make independent choices and the collective role society plays in shaping a progressive future. Informal conversations after the screening brought out key insights on how traditional gender norms continue to influence women's lives, the necessity of creating equal opportunities, and how empowerment contributes to broader national progress. The screening reinforced the idea that achieving a truly inclusive society requires conscious efforts to challenge stereotypes and support gender equity in all spheres.


