Meeting Discussions:

During the department meeting held on January 25, 2024, several important points were discussed for the upcoming even semester in 2024:

1. Special Lecture on the New Forest Act:

It was decided to conduct a special lecture to raise awareness among students about the new Forest Act. Dr. Mousami Debbarma, Assistant Professor from the Department of Geography at Tripura University, was proposed as the resource person for this lecture.

Faculty members will be responsible for mapping out the areas to be visited by different groups, preparing questionnaires, and obtaining the necessary permissions. Field visits will continue throughout the even semester, and some visits may include engagement activities with the villagers.

4. Focus on Publication:

It was proposed to emphasize project work for 6th-semester students with the goal of publishing 2-3 articles with their involvement. A **Special Session on "Literature Review"** will be arranged to equip 6th-semester students with the necessary research skills.

5. Mental Health Session:

Recognizing the importance of mental health, a dedicated session on mental health will be conducted to address the well-being of both students and faculty members.

6. Allocation of specific topics and units

Each faculty member has been assigned specific topics and units from the syllabus for the upcoming semester, aligning with their expertise and areas of specialization. This thoughtful allocation aims to ensure a cohesive and comprehensive coverage of the curriculum, enhancing the overall learning experience for our students.
