## Department of Sociology Assignment Academic Year 2024-25 (Odd Semester)

This is to inform all Socology honours, 5th semester students that you are required to submit an activity based assignment. The deadline for submission is November 18, 2024.

For this assignment, you are divided into five teams and each team is assigned a particular task.

**Team Symbol** members must collect or click different symbols or signs from their surroundings and explain the meaning of these signs. Individual team members will gather and add their meanings along with their names. At the end, team members will mention the importance of symbols or signs in society in 200 words.
