
Key Details:

Furthermore, make sure you clearly label relationships (e.g., father, mother, son, daughter, uncle, aunt, cousin).
2. Identify the clan/gotra in your community and mention its significance
3. Marks: 20
4. Submission Deadline: Completed assignments must be submitted by March 17, 2025.

- Creativity and neat presentation will be considered in grading.
